

Postdoctoral Fellow Position in Geophysics/Earthquake Science at Harvard University

Job Description:

Professor Brendan Meade (<https://brendanmeade.github.io/>) invites applications for a Postdoctoral Fellow position. We have an open position for a postdoctoral fellow with a background in geophysics, earthquake science, or other similarly quantitative fields. Research projects will be focused on imaging earthquake cycle kinematics, statistical earthquake cycle models, large-scale data (geologic and geodetic) integration, and novel dynamical systems modeling. The appointment is initially for one year with the possibility of an extension two more years for a total of a three-year appointment.

Qualifications:

A Ph.D. in Geophysics, Earthquake Science, or other similarly quantitative fields is required at the time of appointment.

Application Process:

Interested candidates should submit a cover letter, CV, a one-page research summary, and three references' names and contact information. Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis until the position is filled. Applications should be submitted through ARIES Harvard's university-wide system for administering academic searches (<https://academicpositions.harvard.edu/postings/13947>).
