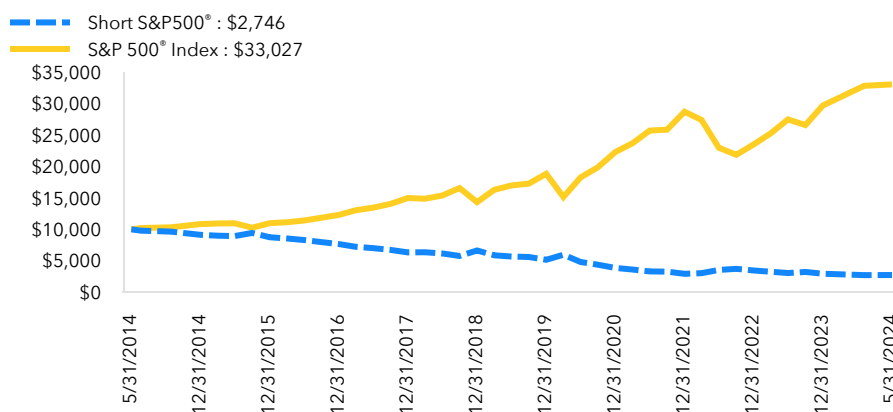

### How Did the Fund Perform Last Year?

Short S&P500<sup>®</sup> (the "Fund") seeks daily investment results, before fees and expenses, that correspond to the inverse (-1x) of the daily performance of the S&P 500<sup>®</sup> Index (the "Index"). The Fund invests in financial instruments that the Advisor believes, in combination, should produce daily returns consistent with the Fund's investment objective. For the year ended May 31, 2024, the Fund had a total return of -15.21% and an average daily statistical correlation of over 0.99 to the inverse of the return of the Index. For the same period, the Index had a total return of 28.19% and a volatility of 11.43%. The index performance was driven by factors such as post-pandemic economic expansion and exuberance for AI and the "Magnificent Seven" companies. Primary factors affecting Fund performance include the total return of the derivatives held by the Fund, the performance of the reference assets to which any derivatives are linked, financing rates paid or earned, the types of derivative contracts used and their correlation to the Fund's Index, expenses, transaction costs, the volatility of the Fund's Index (and its impact on compounding), and other miscellaneous factors.
