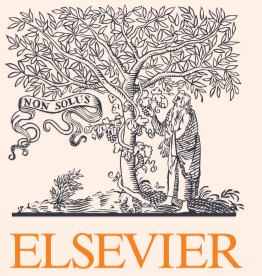


What do sustainability assessment and reporting frameworks measure?

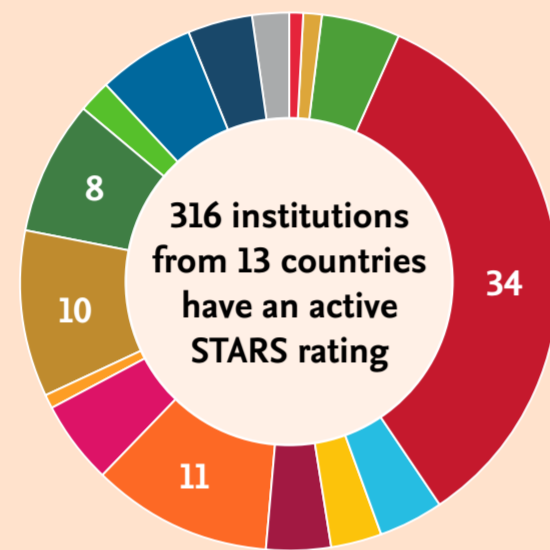

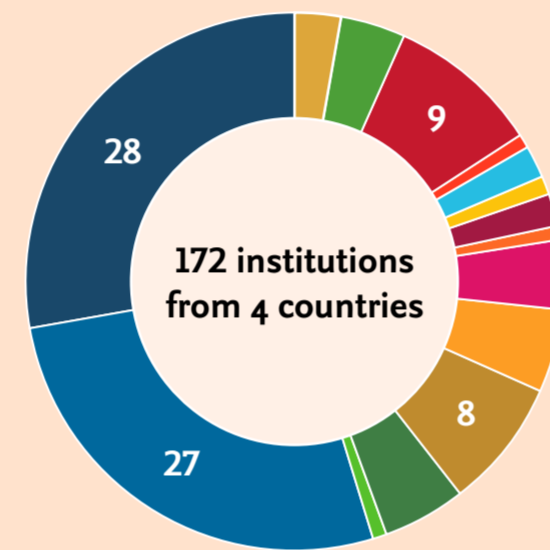

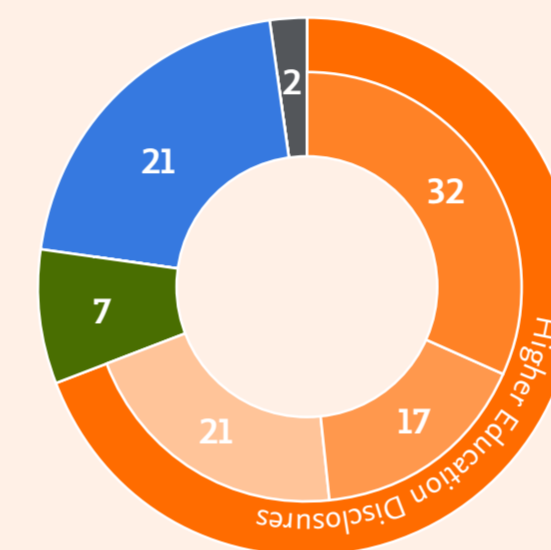

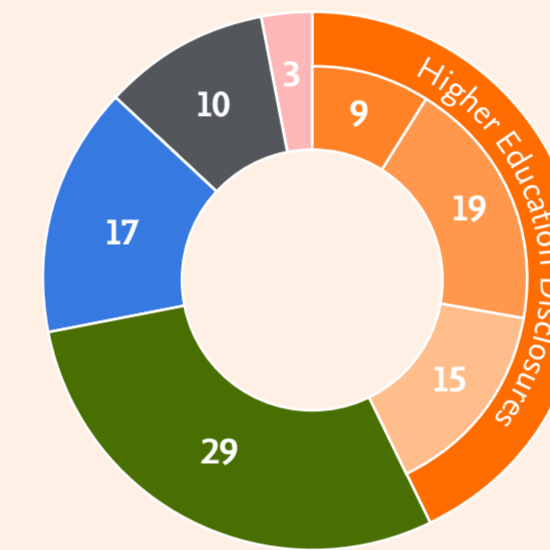

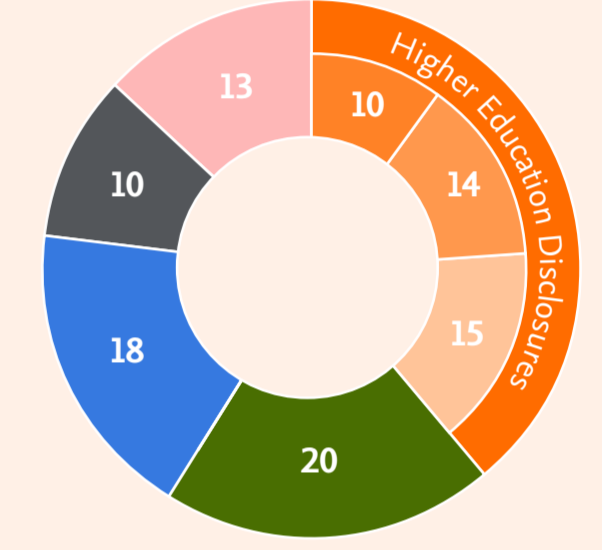

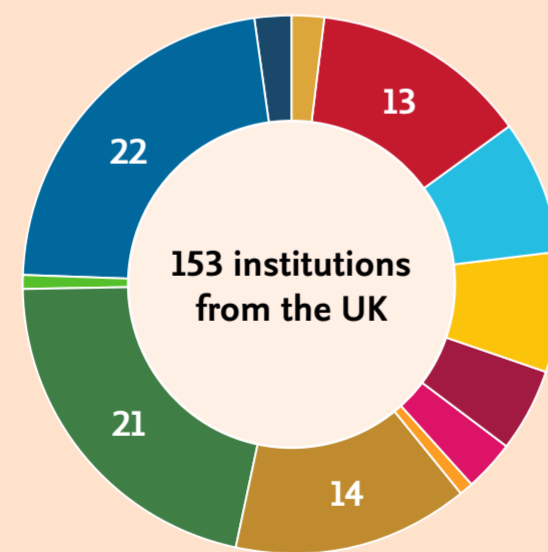

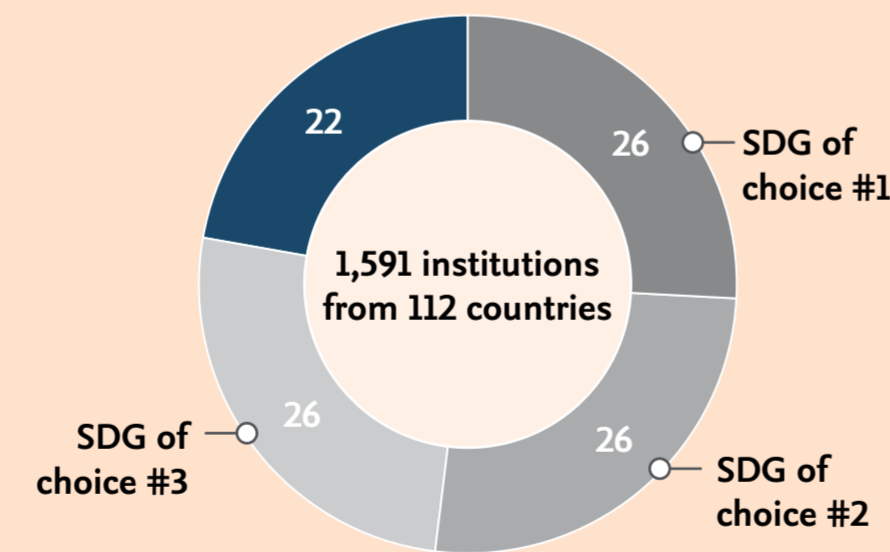

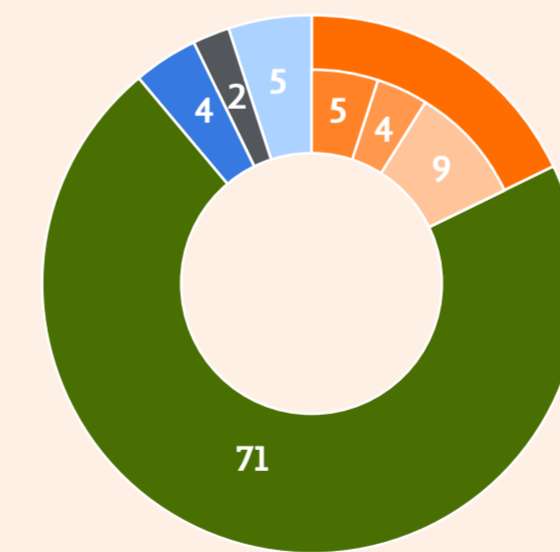

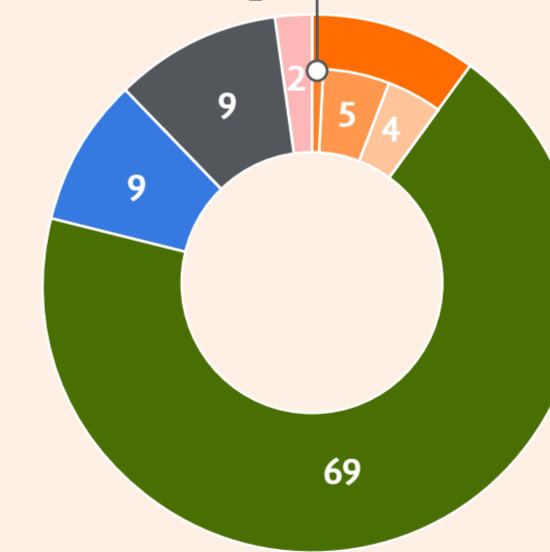

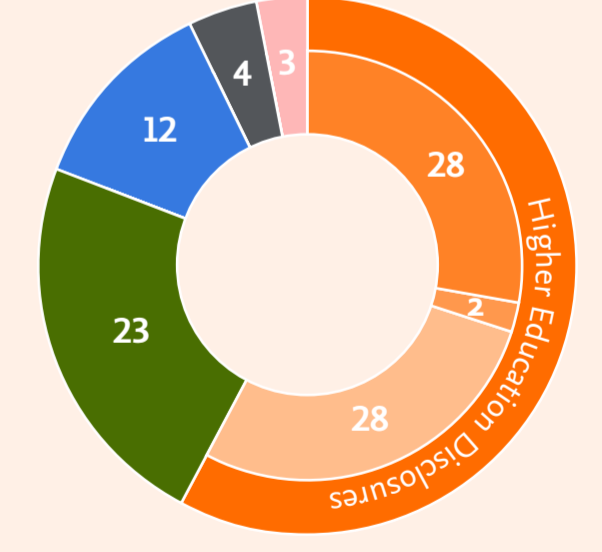
