The image that you have to put together corresponds to a region in the sky colloquially called "The pillars of creation". In this region, made of gas and dust, baby stars are being created! The photograph was taken with a big telescope that is in space called the Hubble Space Telescope. This telescope acts as a giant magnifier that allows us to see what's in our Universe!
