NATURE'S MAGICAL MOMENTS CALENDAR

JAN. Bald eagles start nesting
Cranefly orchids display purple & green leaves
Tundra swans & diving ducks overwinter
Juncos & white-throated sparrows arrive
Skunk cabbage transforms from female to male

FEB. Flying squirrels huddle in trees hollows and squirrel boxes
Maple syruping heats up
Hunt for multi-million-year-old sharks' teeth & other fossils
Long-tailed salamanders breed (over 50 species in VA)
Great blue herons return to heronries

MAR. Wood frogs mate & spring peeper frogs "wail"
Black-crowned night herons return to National Zoo
Ospreys return and snow geese begin to depart
Woodcocks display
Hepatica blooms

APR. Flower explosion includes Virginia bluebells
Great blue herons & cormorants nest at Great Falls
Ruby-throated hummingbirds return
National Arboretum azaleas start blooming
Morel mushroom hunting

MAY Millions of trillium carpet Thompson WMA
Horseshoe crab & shorebird frenzy on DE beaches
Orchids, mountain laurels, & pitcher plants bloom
Peak migration of more than 30 warblers
Diamondback terrapins lay eggs

JUNE Fawns born
Mulberries and blueberries ripen
Common milkweed & wild rhododendrons bloom
Baby birds abound
Fireflies in DMV (synchronous in NC/SC)

JULY Lotuses peak
Sunflowers peak
Mating timber rattlesnakes
Passionflowers & hibiscus bloom
Blackberries ripen

AUG. American goldfinches nest
Shorebird migration
Ghost crabs patrol beaches
Jewelweed (hummer magnet) blooms
Bats put on show at dusk

SEPT. Paw paw fruit ripens
Monarch butterflies migrate
Chimney swifts flock
Earthquake fault visible at National Zoo
Gray catbirds gobble pokeweed berries

OCT. Sharp-shinned hawks migrate
Fringed gentians bloom
Brook trout spawn
Fall color peaks
Dig for fossils at MD's Dinosaur Park

NOV. Fall-blooming camellias
Bald eagles mass at Conowingo Dam
Whitetail deer rut
Winter ducks arrive
Persimmons turn edible

DEC. Saw whet owls visit
Asiatic bittersweet fruits ripen
Snow buntings hang out by manure
Christmas fern brightens forests
Wild mistletoe stands out in trees
