2) Dec. 15 2021 - Deadline for PhD Prize Application Submission.

Each IAU Division has, once a year, the opportunity to award its own prize to a candidate it feels has carried out the most remarkable work in the previous year (i.e. a PhD Thesis which has been defended between the 16 December in the previous year, and 15 December this year).
